Thank you for returning your survey

A huge thank you to all residents and leaseholders who have taken part in our recent consultation exercises including completing surveys and attending the drop in sessions. We've been having really useful conversations with you over the past few weeks during our door knocking and home visits. You've been telling us your views about your homes and what the future for your block should look like.

Sharing survey results

Following the letter from Haringey Council on 13 June 2014, explaining that there will be a need to identify a solution for your home, an initial pre-consultation survey was sent to all residents on your estate in June 2014. Over a six week period, we encouraged your community to have their say on the type of improvements residents would like to see.

The feedback from your surveys is being analysed. Headline results will be available at the fun day and the full report in September.

What happens next?

Building surveyor Keegans Limited has been appointed to carry out a detailed survey of Tangmere. They will require access to every home to do this. Keegans will write to you to arrange a convenient time. Keegans surveyors will wear an identification badge and won't mind waiting while you check it so that you feel safe with them entering your home.

You will have received an invitation already to attend the Tangmere **fun day** on **Saturday 30 August 2014, 11.30am – 4.00pm at Tangmere block (deck level)**. There will be face painting for kids, hot halal lunch and much more. Keegans will be able to answer any of your questions. An officer from the Repairs team will be there.
